Description of the employer:

The Sports Directorate defines the national strategy of the State and designs and interministerial public policies for sports. It implements these policies, or promotes their implementation, relying in particular on the networks of decentralized services, its public establishments and technical sports advisors (CTS). In particular, it has jurisdiction over sports federations, in accordance with the delegation or approval it grants them.

The French Federation of Rollerblading and Skateboarding:

With more than 10 million practitioners in France, rollerblading, skateboarding and scootering are generating a strong popular following. In August 2016, skateboarding entered the closed circle of Olympic disciplines. During its first participation in the Olympic Games in Tokyo in 2021, France was among the 5 nations to qualify at least 5 athletes, with a presence in each event. Of the 5 athletes, 3 have reached the finals.

Skateboarding will also be scheduled in 2024 in Paris and the FFRS has an ambition to succeed with a goal of medals in street and bowl.

- -61.897 members in 2019-2020 (about 4000 in skateboard)
- -900 clubs (about 175 in skateboard for more than 200 educators)
- -13 leagues (regional)
- -56 Committees (departmental)
- -5 million skateboarders in France
