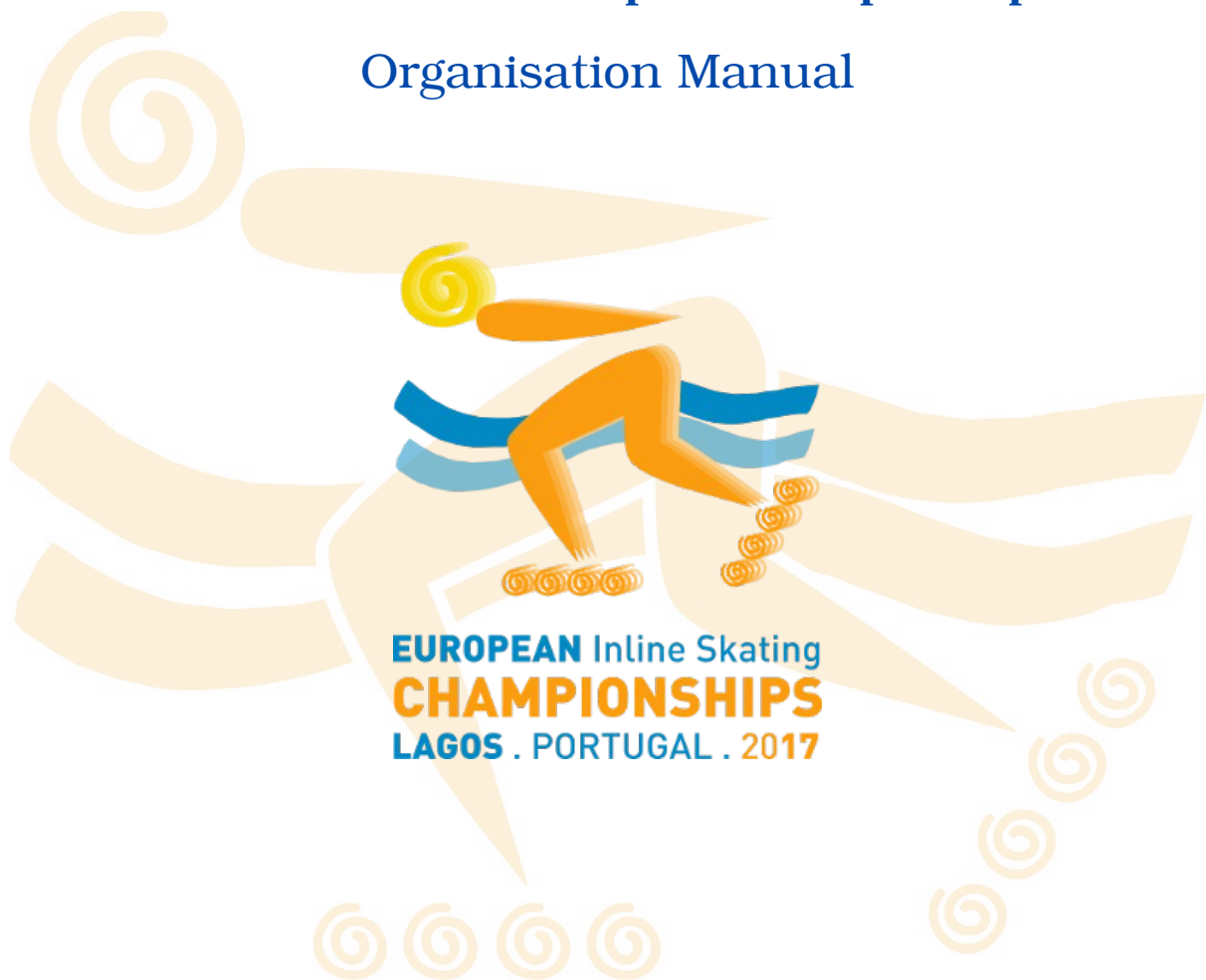

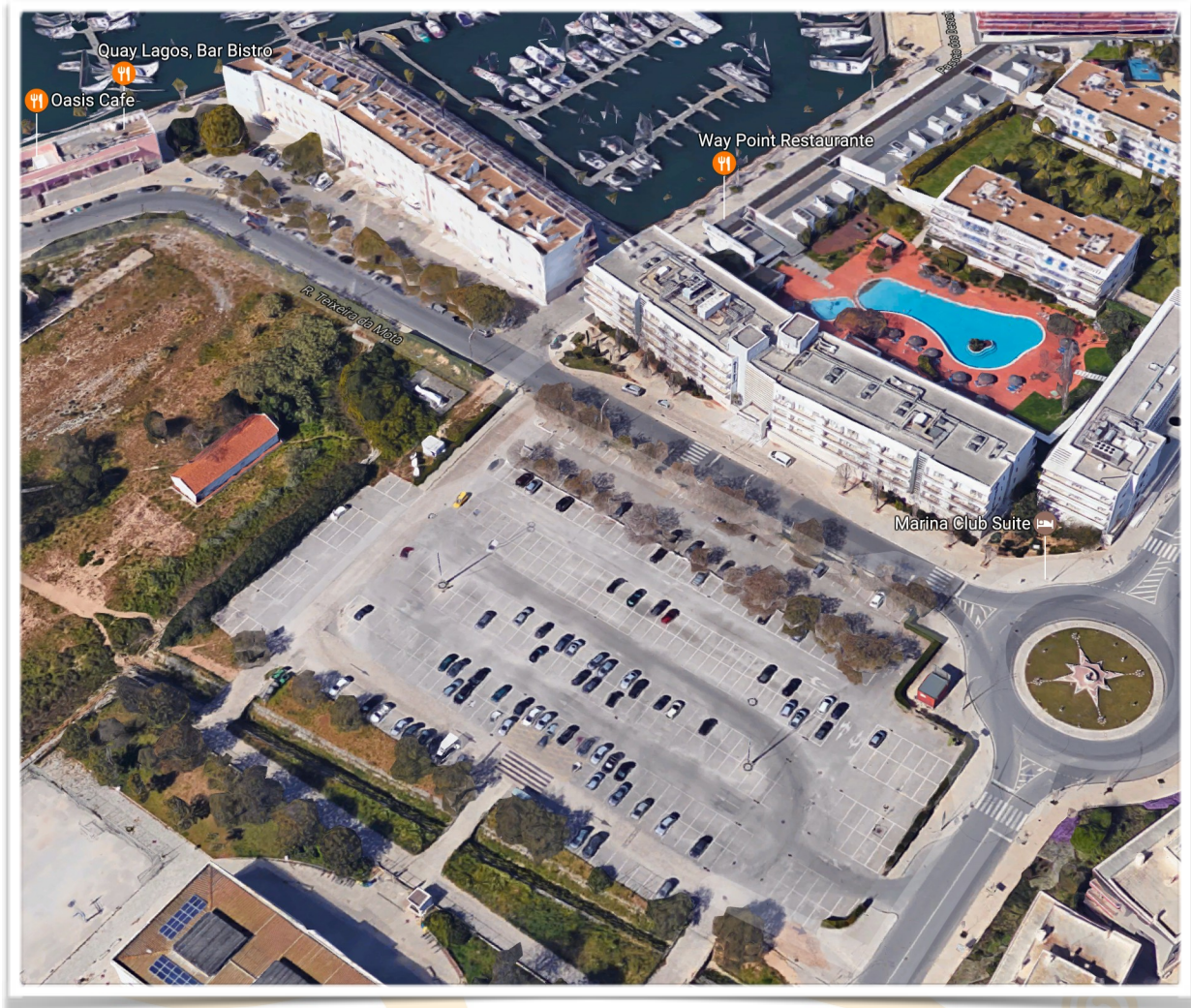

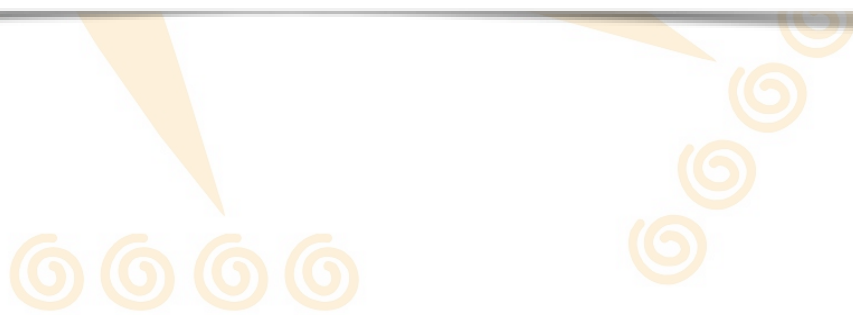

1.4. CERS / CEC Sport Rules

The CEC Official Regulations (Sports Rules) - 2016 edition with the latest amendments - and CERS Rules will be valid for these Championships.

1.5. Participation Conditions

participation is allowed only to countries affiliated to CERS and updated with their CERS fees.

SENIOR European Championship

- A total of eight male and eight female skaters may be registered in the Championship for each attending country.
- No more than three (3) male and three (3) female skaters can participate in each distance/calendar events.

JUNIOR A European Championship

- A total of eight male and eight female skaters may be registered in the Championship for each attending country.
- No more than three (3) male and three (3) female skaters can participate in each distance/calendar events.

JUNIOR B European Championship

- A total of eight male and eight female skaters may be registered in the Championship for each attending country.
- No more than three (3) male and three (3) female skaters can participate in each distance/calendar events.



Skaters allowed to participate at the European Championships must have the following age:

SENIOR Category

- 20 years old (born in 1997 - whole year) and older

JUNIOR A Category

- 18 years old (born in 1999 - whole year)
- 19 years old (born in 1998 - whole year)

JUNIOR B Category

- 16 years old (born in 2001 - whole year)
- 17 years old (born in 2000 - whole year)

CADETS

Higher start for the oldest Cadets in the Junior B Category

- 15 years old (born in 2002 - whole year)

1.6. Checks

Anti-Doping Control

Anti-doping controls will be carried out according to CERS/FIRS Medical Regulations and WADA Rules.

Check of Female Sex

No female sex certificate is required. Nevertheless, in conformity with IOC guidelines, CERS/CEC is entitled to conduct tests on specific occasions. This would mean laboratory tests could be done if there is a suspicion.



1.7. Examination Session for Judges

An examination session for International judge level will be during the Championship.

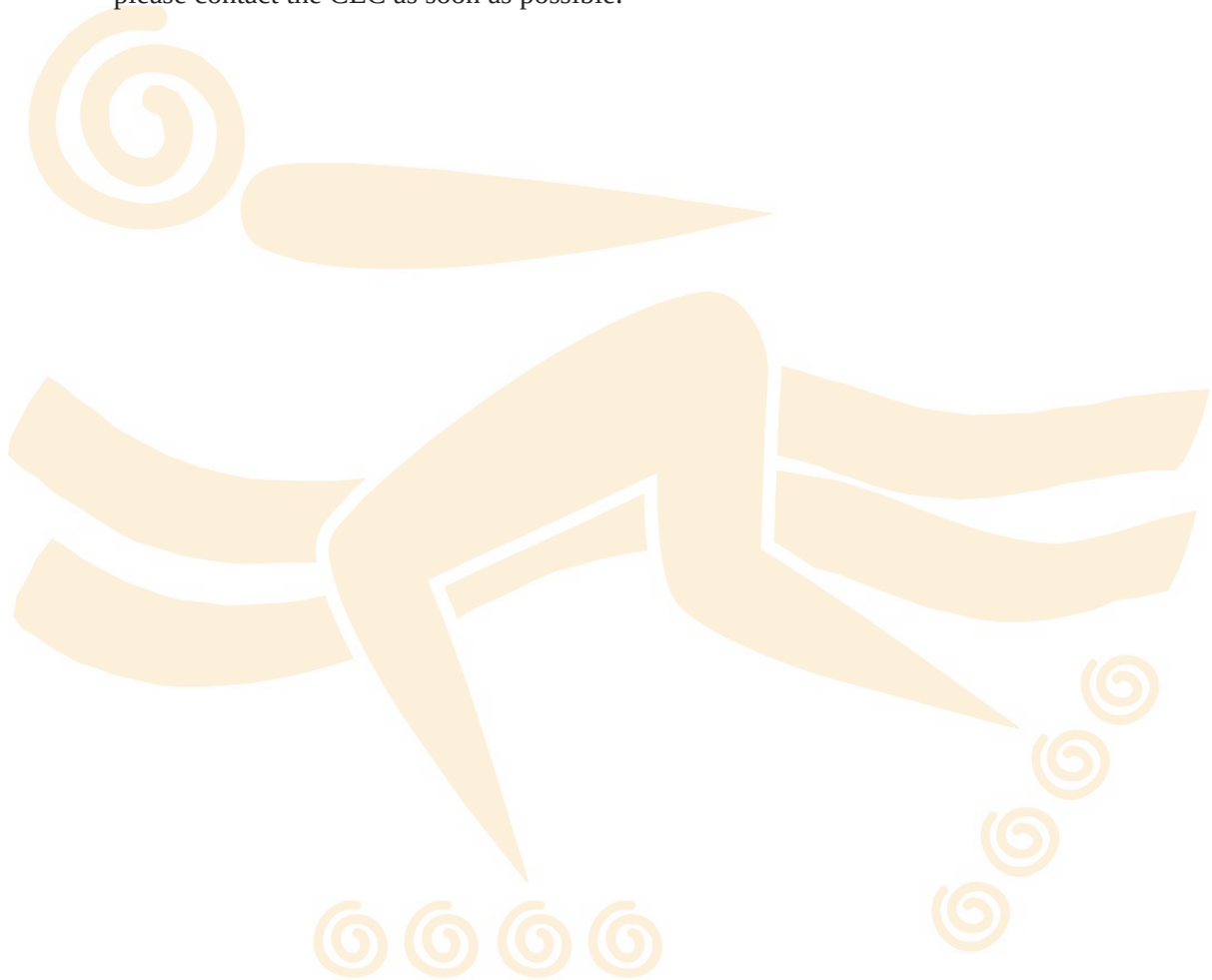

For assistance to obtain a Portuguese entry visa or require a specific letter of invitation, please contact the CEC as soon as possible.





2. Operational Part

2.1. Preparation of the Championships

2.1.1. Financial Conditions and Fees payment

Each participating country will pay the following entry fees:

- NO fee for each country participating at the Senior/ Junior A/Junior B Championship
- EUR 60,00 - for each senior, junior A, junior B and cadet skater entered for the Track Championship
- EUR 60,00 - for each senior, junior A, junior B and cadet skater entered for the Road Championship
- EUR 10,00 - for each additional skater in the marathon (maximum 2 per country and category)

Fees must be paid (without additional bank expenses for CEC) until **JUN 22, 2017**. The fees will be summed up in an invoice which will be sent to the federations after the arrival of the registration form by country (see 2.1.2).

Each participating team will pay its own traveling, board and lodging expenses.

2.1.2.3. Check (Passports and Entry Fees)

Scheduled on June 29, 2017 between 10.00 at the track in Lagos. Delegates of all attending countries are kindly requested to be present in order to confirm their entry and nationality of the skaters:

- Presentation of the passports of all attending athletes
- Registration forms per race and category have to be handed in filled out with the attending skaters of all races of Track Championship. (document: XXX_soon_XXX)
- No payments in cash accepted at registration (see 2.1)
- Delegates must submit a corresponding proof/photocopy of the payment (e-banking)

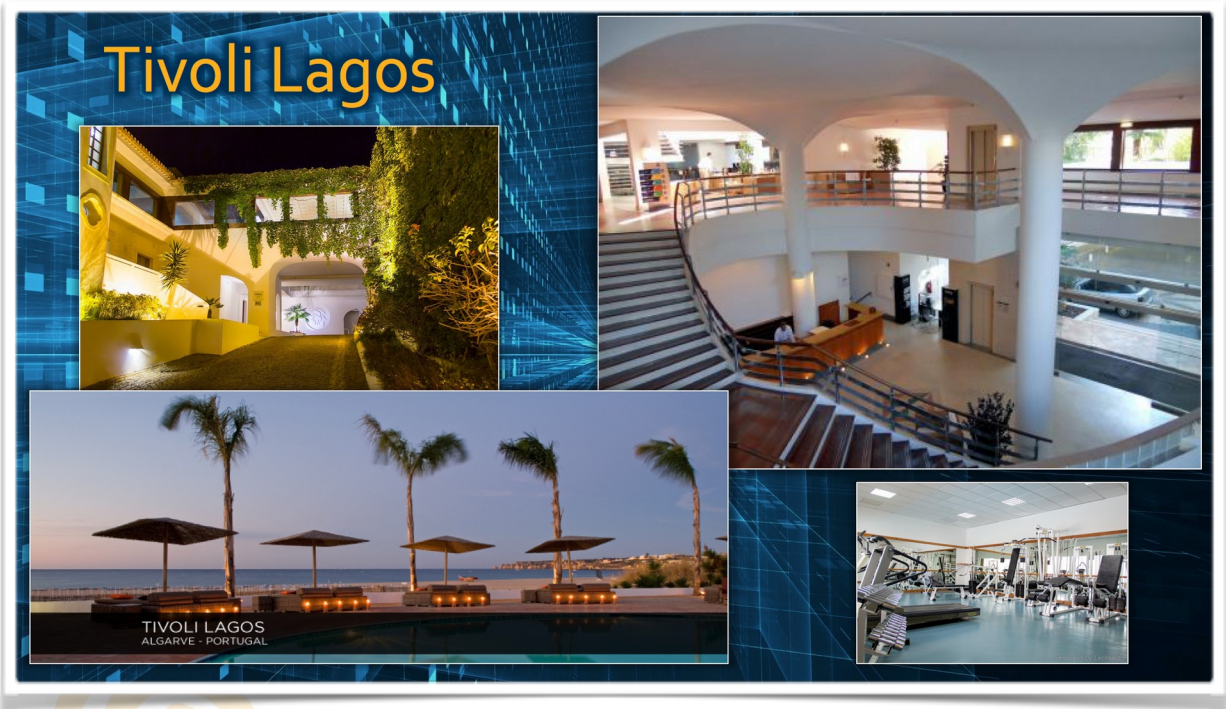

2.3.1. Liability / Responsibility

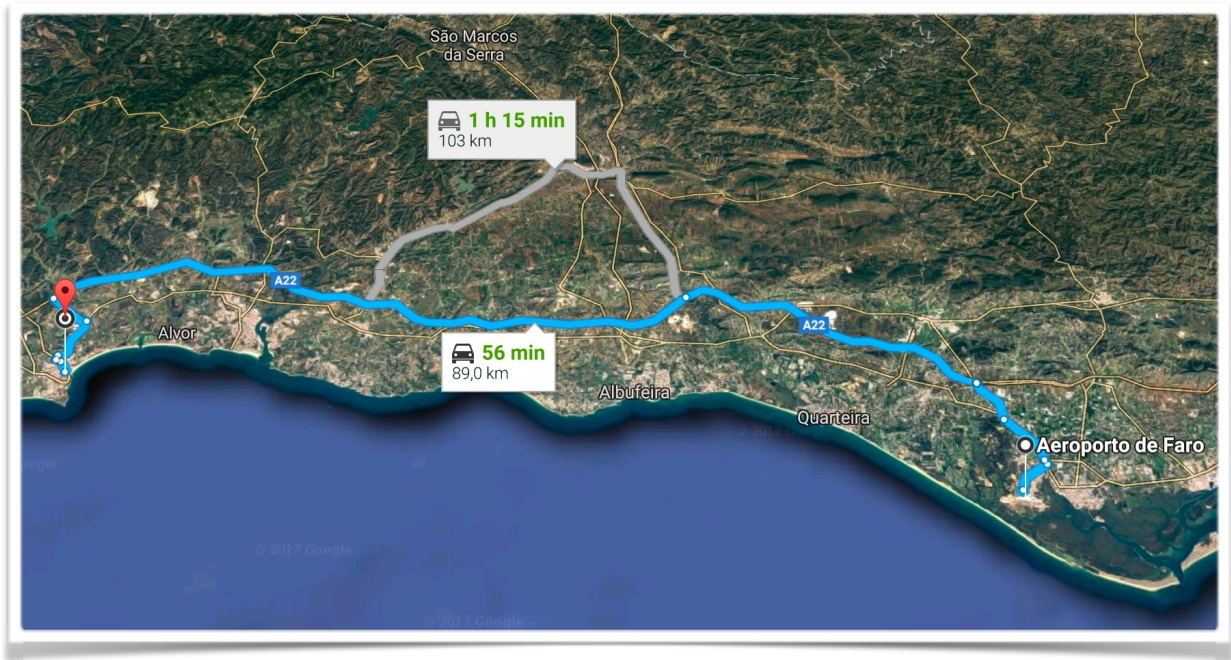
The Comité Européen de Course and the organiser are not responsible for any accident that may occur during travel, before, during or after the event /championships.
